

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Player participation is a privilege rather than a right.
2. Players who exercise this privilege shall consequently be expected to exemplify high standards of behavior.
3. The use or possession of illegal drugs or alcohol will not be allowed or tolerated.
4. The use of tobacco will not be allowed or tolerated.
5. Stealing or vandalism of any property is prohibited.
6. Profanity of any form will not be tolerated, on or off the field.
7. Criticism of officials or team members will not be allowed.
8. Courtesy will be shown to other team players, officials or fans at all times.
9. Attending and being prompt for every practice and game is mandatory, unless excused by the coach.
10. Maintaining a healthy physical condition and mental attitude to the best of the player's ability is required.
11. Team play will be required at all times.
12. Players will conduct themselves to the highest degree possible, because they represent themselves, their team, their coach and their city.
13. Any player kicked off the field by an official, while being a spectator, may not practice or play game(s) until the coach has given the player permission.

ENFORCEMENT OF THE PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Major violations of the Player's Code of Conduct will be brought before the Brookings Soccer Club's Board of Directors. The Board of Directors, if need be, will appoint a Discipline Committee to investigate the situation. The Discipline Committee shall conduct a prompt and fair hearing to hear such matters. The decision of the Discipline Committee will be final.
